ORANGE COUNTY COASTKEEPER BRINGS "RIGS TO REEFS" VR DIVE EXPERIENCE TO THE 2024 OC FAIR

Orange County Coastkeeper (Coastkeeper) will host an interactive experience in the Sand and Sea exhibit at the 2024 Orange County Fair (Fair), opening Friday, July 19, 2024. With the help of virtual reality headsets, fairgoers will dive 100 feet underwater to discover the thriving marine ecosystems beneath California's aging oil rigs.

Due to failing infrastructure and low productivity, California's oil rigs must soon be decommissioned. However, the underwater structures have become some of the most biodiverse and ecologically valuable marine ecosystems in the state. Coastkeeper and other ocean advocates have called for the state to prioritize a Rigs to Reefs program, which would transition offline oil rigs into artificial reefs and preserve the ocean life that utilizes the underwater structure.

Coastkeeper has joined the Fair to educate fairgoers on these unique environments and garner community support for a Rigs to Reefs program in California. While progress has been made through legislative and advocacy efforts, none of the state's 27 oil rigs have yet been transitioned to artificial reefs. By engaging fairgoers with an immersive virtual reality diving experience, Coastkeeper hopes to inspire more proponents of Rigs to Reefs.

"We're excited to show fairgoers something they've likely never seen before – the vibrant underwater world beneath California's oil rigs," said Matt Sylvester, communications director at Orange County Coastkeeper. "The virtual reality dive experience is an incredible tool for introducing people to the Rigs to Reefs concept. Once participants resurface from their dive, they become invested in this complex environmental issue and want to learn more."

Coastkeeper staff members will operate the virtual reality experience from 12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. every day of the Fair (July 19 to August 18, 2024). The Sand



and Sea exhibit, which includes Coastkeeper's virtual reality experience alongside other activities, is free with Fair admission.

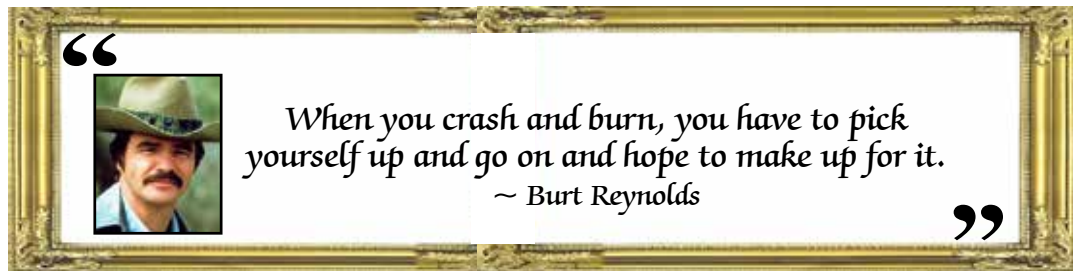

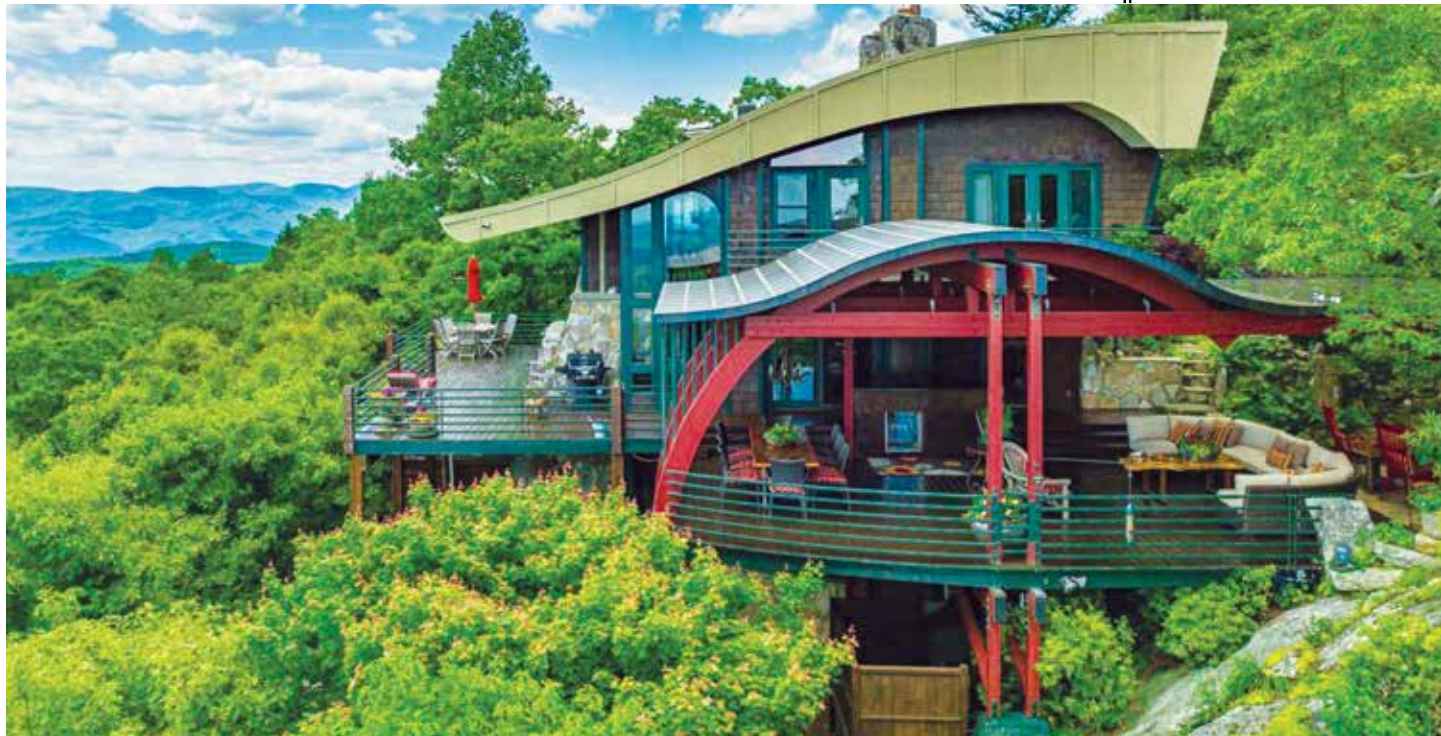

BURT REYNOLDS' MOUNTAIN GETAWAY SELLS \$2.9 MILLION



Hollywood's highest-paid actor from 1978 to 1982, Burt Reynolds was a true cultural icon. One part high school football hero and one part theater nerd, a young Burt Reynolds won both a Florida State Drama Award and a football scholarship to Florida State University. When a series of injuries took him off the football field, he turned to acting full-time, moving to New York to pursue his career. He was told that he would never make it in Hollywood because he looked too much like Marlon Brando, but he proved his critics wrong. His breakout role came in 1962 when he was cast on *Gunsmoke*. *Butch Cassidy and the Sundance Kid* was his star turn. His 1972 nude centerfold in *Cosmopolitan* is still an endearing symbol of masculinity. The prolific star would go on to win two Golden Globes and a Primetime Emmy. Active until he died in 2018, Burt's final film was *The Last Movie Star*.

While he was filming *Deliverance* in North Carolina, Burt fell in love with the tranquil beauty of the Blue Ridge Mountains. With his then-wife, actress Loni Anderson, Reynolds purchased a home in Highlands, North Carolina. Built by Frank Lloyd Wright protege Jim Fox, Burt's former home just sold for \$2.9 million.

Not the typical log cabin home that is common to the mountains, Burt's modern-style home is as interesting and unique as Burt's life was. Blending seamlessly into the surrounding mountainscape and fully embodying the principles of organic architecture, the centerpiece of the home is a wraparound porch with huge mountain views and intricate woodwork. Inside, the home continues the natural materials theme, with one-of-a-kind wooden walls incorporating tree trunks and unique angles. The sunken living room with a natural stone fireplace exudes a rustic charm that once hosted Hollywood stars such as Sally Field and James Garner. Downstairs, a gorgeous stone bathroom was built personally by Loni for Burt. Once asked about the home, Reynolds had this to say: "I own about fourteen houses. Whenever I am asked which one is my favorite, without a moment's hesitation I always say my house in the mountains."

The home was built in 1972 - the same year *Deliverance* was made. The home's current owners had the property for 23 years, enhancing the home in line with its original vision. A recent remodel expanded the terrace, adding a large stone fireplace, an in-



ground heated plunge pool/hot tub and waterfall, a serving bar, and both sitting and dining areas. Other features of the home include a wine cellar and a pool table room.

Recently named *Travel and Leisure Magazine's Best Small Mountain Town*, Highlands has only about 1,000 residents. It is located within the Nantahala National Forest, renowned for its waterfalls and stunning fall foliage. Driving distance from Nashville, Charleston, and Charlotte, it serves as

a summer getaway destination and is home to some of the top-rated resorts in the southern US. And Burt wasn't the only Hollywood star to fall in love with the area: Steve Martin, Stephen King, and Nicole Kidman are just a few A-listers with nearby homes.

Taste of Wine & Food

EXPLORING TEMECULA: FALKNER WINERY/ PINNACLE RESTAURANT & WIENS CELLARS

When Ray Falkner invited Frank and I to Falkner Winery to explore their new Spring/Summer Mediterranean menu at their Pinnacle Restaurant, our answer was an easy yes. I was especially excited to try their new plant-based items. A bonus was that Frank's son, Ron Mangio, was visiting from Dallas and was able to join us. Our trip also included a visit to Wiens Cellars as well.

We started our Falkner visit progressing through their latest wines. Wine server Andy Sanchez and winemaker Duncan Williams took us through the VIP Experience with a few extras on either end. First up was the 2023 Chardonnay and Viognier. The Chardonnay had ripe apple, honey dew melon, and guava on the palate. The Viognier had nice floral notes including honeysuckle and orange blossom with peach and melon tickling my taste buds. The VIP Experience started with 2022 Sauvignon Blanc, a 2022 Wine Enthusiasts Editor's Pick, with lime, kiwi, and a hint of pear that was super refreshing. 2022 Dry Rose blending 85% Syrah and 15% Malbec and a splash of Zinfandel was 2nd in the lineup. 2020 Sangiovese Estate Vintner's Reserve was next with medium body and tastes of cherry, raspberry, and hints of licorice and cardamon on the finish. The 2021 Amante Super Tuscan-style blend with Sangiovese, Merlot, Cab Franc, and Cabernet Sauvignon and 2021 Meritage Bordeaux blend with Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Cab Franc completed the VIP tasting. We also had a pouring of the 2021 Syrah. The final three we tasted, Amante, Meritage, and Syrah were my favorites of the day.

After our wine tasting, we sat down for lunch at Pinnacle. Having been voted "Best Restaurant" for 2007-2024 by readers of Inland Empire Magazine, Pinnacle Restaurant at Falkner Winery continues to impress and improve. Enjoying healthy food, highlights Pinnacle's new Spring/Summer Menu. Mediterranean cooking involves the use of olive oils, fruits, nuts, seafood, and wine and was an objective for the new menu. Executive Chef Ever Fuentes and his staff along with Proprietor Ray Falkner introduced numerous and unique new items to the menu while retaining guest favorites. The new menu incorporates some new and revamped offerings organized as Small Plates, Large Plates, Entrées, Plant-Based, and Desserts. Chef Ever reintroduced a previous Pinnacle favorite: the BLATT or Bacon, Lettuce, Tomato, and Turkey on ciabatta bread sandwich served with homemade potato chips. The new plant-based menu includes Eggplant Parmigiana, Linguini alla Bolognese, Portobello Mushroom Risotto, Grilled Vegetable Napoleon, and Rotini alla Puttanesca. We started lunch with the Rotini and Linguini entrees and then we had the Eggplant and Napoleon entrees.

These entrees were impressive. Falkner commented, "We wanted to create fundamental dishes that are health conscious that don't sacrifice flavor." He also added, "Our goal was to create complex dishes outside of what many would attempt at home." Ever and Falkner, checked both boxes.

Our third round of entrees included meat-based protein plates, specifically the reintroduced BLATT, new Pinnacle burger served with seasoned fries, and new Sea Bass with grilled artichokes.

These carnivore delights were amazing. Guests can pair a glass or bottle of any Falkner wines for a delicious meal whether you want a lighter, plant-based Mediterranean meal or indulge with a meat-based entrée. Additionally, guests can enjoy five craft beers and a wide variety of cocktails made with high-end spirits.

Save room for dessert to enjoy one of their new special desserts including Creamy Chocolate Cake and house-made Tiramisu. We had the chocolate cake along with an extravagant Espresso Martini for dessert. Reservations are recommended and can be made by calling the restaurant at 951-676-8231, online on their website, or using OpenTable.

Hats off for an outstanding day of wine tasting and exceptional cuisine. Thank you Ray, Duncan, Andy, and Chef Evers. For those heading out to Temecula, put Falker/Pinnacle at the top of your list. More info at falknerwinery.com.

WIENS CELLARS

Our second stop for the day was Wiens Cellars. Wiens started with a vision to create high-quality, hand-crafted Southern California wines that tell a unique story from vine to glass.

They planted their first vineyard by hand in 1996. The initial five varieties laid the foundation for a diverse portfolio of over thirty, and a modest 14-acre vineyard grew into more than 70 acres of hand-cultivated vines.

Donna Weisbruch, Tasting Room Sales Manager, paired our trio up with Tim Llorico, Wine Specialist, for a four-pour tasting. We started off with 2020 Reunion, an Estate Syrah (64%) and La Cresta Cabernet Sauvignon (36%) blend with red cherry and hints of white pepper and fennel flavor profile. Next, we had 2019 Primitivo (100%) sourced from Lodi. Strawberry and plum dominated the palate. The third pouring was 2020 Bare Knuckle Petite Sirah blended with 14% Zinfandel to elevate the fruit and spice notes. This was a heavy hitter with a classic blueberry palate expected of the concentrated Petite Sirah berries. Our final pouring was the 2021 Red Blend, with the best of the best Wiens fruit comprised of 50% Cab Sauv, 35% Malbec, and 15% Syrah all sourced from the La Cresta vineyard and aged for 24 months in 25% European oak creating a ripe black fruit palate and powerful tannins. Starting with a Quincy/Temperton medley, she went into her famous songs with James Ingram, 'Baby, Come to Me' from her Every Home Should Have One album and the Oscar-nominated song, 'How Do You Keep The Music Playing.' She ended the evening with 'What the World Needs Now' and came back for one last encore of 'Get Happy' from her For Ella 2 album, with everyone on their feet dancing.

Marienthal's all-star band consisted of Andre Berry on bass guitar and Mitch Forman on keyboards. On drums, Bernie Dresel, Andy Waddell on guitar, and Munyungo Jackson on percussion. Backup singers for Austin were Lynne Fiddmont, Fred White, and Valerie Pinkston.

Lindy Boone Michaelis and Mike Michaelis were honored with the High Hopes Lifetime Achievement Award. Lindy is one of Pat Boone's daughters. Ryan (son of Lindy) fell through a three-story skylight and landed on the concrete below in 2001. They sought help at High Hopes for Ryan's traumatic brain injury. Pat Boone and his family appeared on Larry King LIVE five times, telling Ryan's story when Ryan's Reach Nonprofit was born to help High Hopes and others with TBIs. It is because of this relationship, High Hopes has benefited from Ryan's Reach for many years.

Heartwarming testimonials were shared by Britney Vermes, who regained her life after a stroke with the help of High Hopes, and Ron Young, a High Hopes student with MS who found hope and progress through the program's robotic rehabilitation devices.

The live auction featured exciting items such as a week-long trip on the Chris Botti at Sea Jazz Cruise, a signed Eagles jersey and football by Super Bowl MVP Nick Foles, luxurious jewelry, tickets to Anaheim Ducks games, Broadway shows, and more. 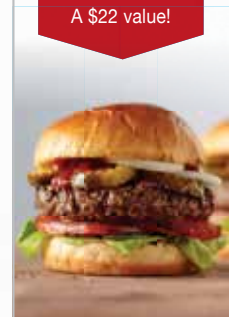

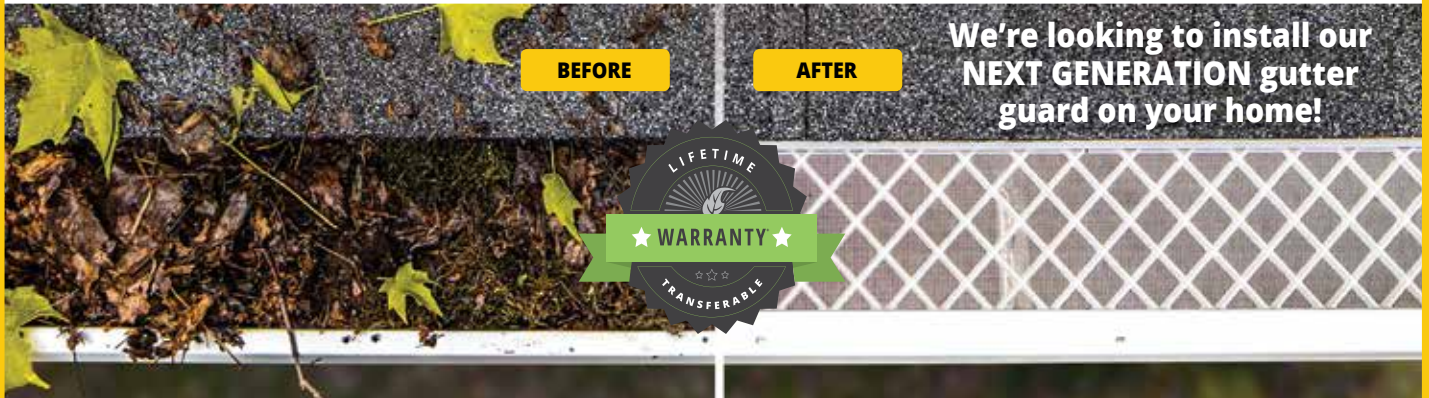
